Revisiting Christian Leadership: What Do Kingdom Leaders Do?

“My concern is that Christian leaders have leveraged our men to build church buildings and run church programs, but we have failed to disciple them in what it means to be about the kingdom.” (Tony Evans, *Kingdom Man*)

What does Christian leadership look like? What do spiritual leaders do? What does it mean to be about the kingdom, to pursue kingdom things? Kingdom leaders are disciples who are discipling others. Kingdom leadership begins with disciples making disciples. A lot of what gets done down at the church house is only loosely connected to what the kingdom of Christ is about.
