
Forward to the Future: the Focus Will Not Change!


I share a brief excerpt from the back cover.

taught in churches, universities, and Bible conferences across the nation and internationally.



Peru Mission Updates

Chimbote, Peru. The renewed mission outreach in Chimbote began in March 2025. Several baptisms have occurred during the past ten months. (picture left, a recent gathering of the church, October 2025)

The LALD commitment is through 2027. This work will be assumed by **Main and Oklahoma church of Christ** in McAlester, Oklahoma, beginning in January 2026.



Colombia Mission Updates

Southern Colombia. Jairo and Andrea continue to do a magnificent work among the churches in southern Colombia. They are diligent in visiting the churches to encourage them, providing online studies by Zoom, and evangelizing.

The responsibility for collecting and sending funds will be assumed by the **Fort Gibson church of Christ** in 2026. The **Springbrook church of Christ in Dewitt, Michigan** partners in this work, helping with the support of Jairo. **Bella Vista church of Christ** (Bella Vista, Arkansas) is the sending partner.



La Hormiga, Putumayo, Colombia. The work in Putumayo continues to grow. Reminder: the cost of renting a larger facility for worship would be \$250-300 per month if a church or individual could help temporarily with a good work. (picture left, an assembly, November 2025)

The responsibility for collecting and sending funds will be assumed by the Fort Gibson church of Christ in 2026. The Holmes Road church

of Christ in Lansing, Michigan is the primary partner in this work. Bella Vista church of Christ is the sending partner.

Dominican Republic Mission Updates

Preaching the Gospel in the Dominican Republic. The establishment and growth of new churches have expanded the number of preachers. The six preachers who were being helped with ministry expenses are now eight. Continuing support is also provided for two preacher widows. The ministries being supported are in Jimaní, La Descubierta, Angel Felix, Postrer Rio, Guayabal, Las Clavellinas, and Neyba. At Guayabal, Simón is assisting Básico because of the involvement of Básico in the several of the works. The work at Higo de la Cruz has been suspended. The possibility of sharing in a new work at Barrero is being evaluated.

In La Descubierta, during the past year additional ministry resources have boosted this work with several baptisms and increased attendance (picture right). Funds have been contributed for 2026. The need for continuing the additional ministry support will be evaluated at end of 2026. A yet unfunded need is repair of the perimeter wall to increase security.

Beginning in 2026, Fort Gibson church of Christ will begin collecting funds for 2027. The Northside church in Mena, Arkansas has been a faithful partner in this work.



Report from Liberte Ministries Build Team, Dominican Republic

In October, the build team from **Liberte Ministries** worked in Las Clavellinas to complete a third church building, along with remodeling an existing church building as a home for a sister in Christ (a widow) and her family who help with the work in that place. Two pictures summarize the story. Pictured left, the previous housing of the widow

who lives on the property with her blind mother and her children. Pictured right, the build team in front of the previous church building, now remodeled into housing for the widow and her

family, with the new church building to the right. To see provisional church buildings being replaced with permanent structures is a great blessing.



With the completion of a new church building, the

work at Las Clavellinas would grow even more rapidly with additional worker. A Dominican brother is available. Lacking is his personal support (\$500 monthly) and the need for a moto.

Nicaragua Mission Update

Nueva Libia, Managua, Nicaragua. Latin American Leadership Development periodically assisted financially with this work for about ten years. The church is active and vibrant, active in evangelism.

The Lapeer, Michigan church of Christ continues to provide support for this work.

Praying about the future....

Upcoming commitments include Baxter in November and Cusco and Curahuasi, Peru in January-February. In 2026 we plan to return to the Dominican Republic to work on strengthening the churches. We thank you for your faithful partnership and look forward to what God will do in us and through us!
